First Imogen showed us a copy of training - 2011 till 17.3.2016

It was noted that the lunch time assistant and the new teaching assistant at East Wold had not had the Safeguarding Children training. HK will check on this to make sure that is carried out.

We looked at the features that should be reported at a full governing body meeting.

We then went through the example from Stoke on Trent Audit Tool. We amended where we thought appropriate and highlighted items that need further investigation. Imogen will type up the amended Audit Tool and circulated it to the safeguarding governors.

Whilst at North Cockerington we checked issues that were raised on our visit on 28.9.15
