

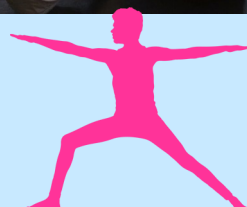
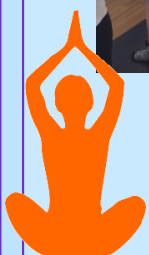

Owl class Yoga

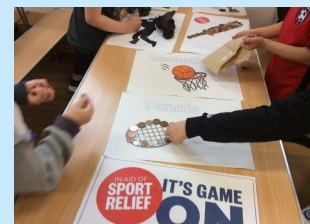
