Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you are all well and able to get out in the super weather.

Here in school we are working hard to plan and prepare for wider opening and to get East Wold up and running again. We know that you may have many questions in relation to how our schools will open and operate as we move forward following Government guidelines and we hope to give answers as soon as we are able.

In order to establish our capacity at both sites, we sent out a parent questionnaire and we are very grateful to those who have sent their replies. For those parents who are Key Workers and have requested a place for your child/children, there will be a place available from 1st June and the Government is encouraging parents to take up this provision (for those already attending Key Worker provision, this will continue). However, if your child is registered at East Wold, they will return to East Wold and likewise if your child is registered at North Cockerington, they will continue to attend North Cockerington. Please could Key Worker parents, who have not yet done so, let us know if and when they will begin sending their child/children back to school.

If you are a Key Worker who has not needed provision before now, we would ask that you email your employer's letter or some other form of evidence of your Key Worker status to Mrs Owen at the enquiries email address, in order that we can confirm your place at school. If you have already provided us with this information, we will not need it again.

There will be further information about plans later this week.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation as we all adjust and work together to move our school communities forward.
