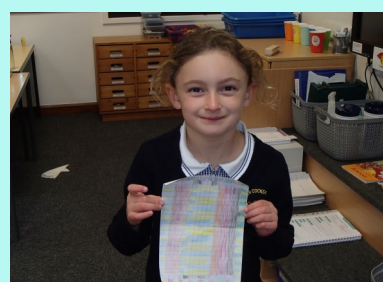
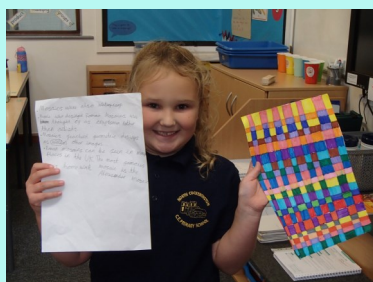

Plastic Pots

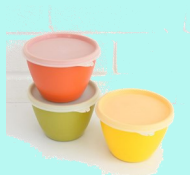
Our caretaker and staff are finding an increasing number of small plastic pots left in classrooms and on the playground.

It's not too late to do this, please let me know and I will send you details how you can register your child if you haven't already done so.

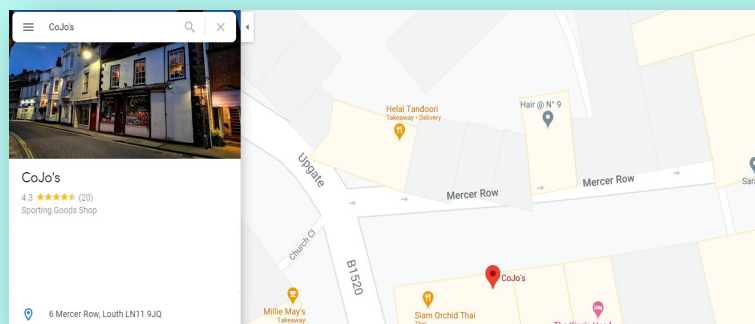

Lunch form reminders

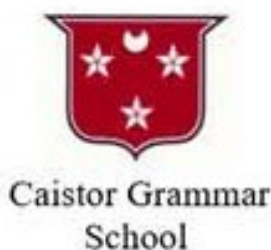
Please remember that if you would like your child to have a school lunch between 12th –22nd October you must submit your form back to the relevant school by **Monday 5th October**.
