## **Robin Class**

Reminders from Miss White:

- Children only need to bring their book bag, lunch box and water bottle to school, as well as a coat. Book bags and water bottles go direct into the class room and coats stay in the cloakroom on a peg. As space is limited, please do not send large bulky backpacks unless absolutely necessary as some children are struggling with the zips and at present we are trying to minimise contact with personal belongings. If your child needs to bring additional items to school due to going home with someone else, then we appreciate this is unavoidable.
- If you wish to send a change of clothing for your child in case of accidents then please do so in a named light weight bag that can be left on their peg.
- From Monday 21st September please remember all the reception children will be in full time. If their start time is 8.45 am, collection will be at 3.15 pm, if their start time is 9.00 am, collection will be at 3.30 pm.

## **Drop off and collection of all pupils:**

As you are aware school is currently operating on staggered start and finish times to aid with social distancing at busy times of the day. From next week, Reception pupils will be in full time so collection may be a little busier than the last two weeks. Please may we remind everyone it is important that you adhere to the 2m social distancing rule and ensure the gateways are clear and not blocked. Staff will be on hand with talkie talkies to let classes know which parents are waiting to collect, your children will then be sent out to you.

Please may we remind you to keep to your allocated start and collection time to help keep everyone safe.

## **Parking**

Please be considerate when parking and manoeuvring vehicles outside school. We have received a report from a member of the public advising of a “near miss” involving a car reversing into Meadow Lane in order to turn around.

We have also noticed several cars being left directly outside school after drop off time. If for whatever reason you need to leave your car, please park down Meadow Lane or on the grass verges down the road. This is due to the fact that we have several large vehicles visiting school regularly to deliver school supplies such as food, oil and to collect the large Biffa Bins and other waste items. When cars are left parked near the gates it makes it very difficult for our service providers to operate safely.

If possible, please try not to park in the two bays directly outside school. These are reserved for school transport and Puddle ducks who have to drop off and collect multiple children.

Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.
