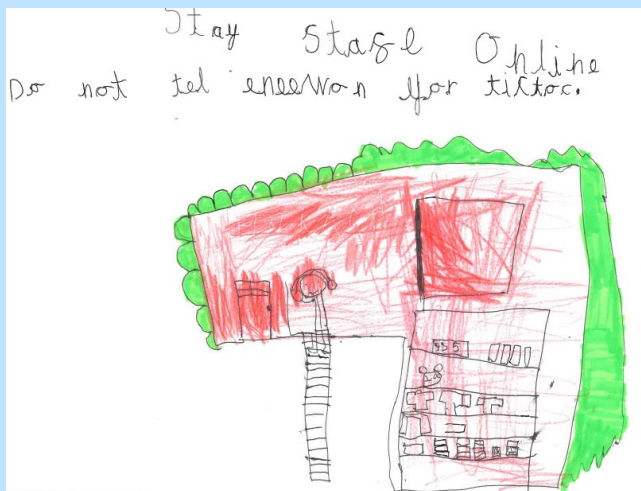
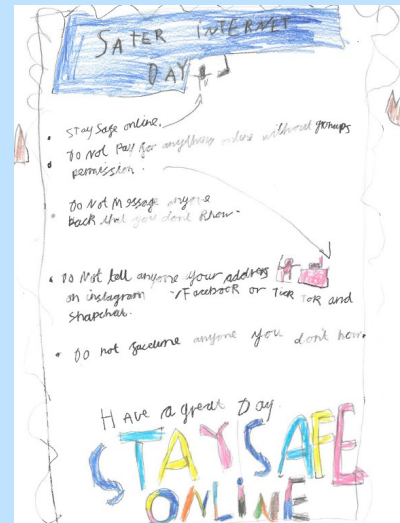
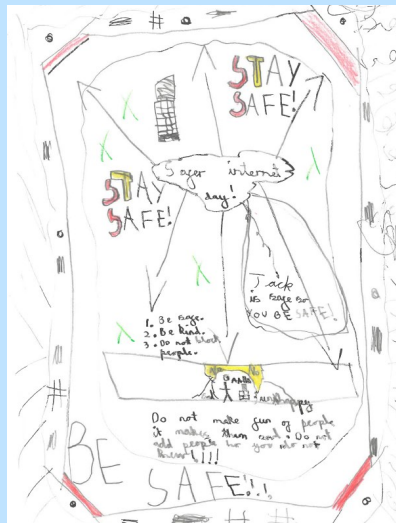

Free School Meals Letter

During the current Coronavirus pandemic, many families have experienced financial hardship and the government voucher system has provided a vital lifeline to support the additional costs that families have incurred with having their children at home. If you are accepted for Free School Meals, then you will be eligible for supermarket vouchers to support towards the lunch costs for your child while they are not attending school. This includes school holidays.

Registering for free meals could also raise an extra £1,345 for your child's school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff, uniform, after school activities and educational trips and visits.

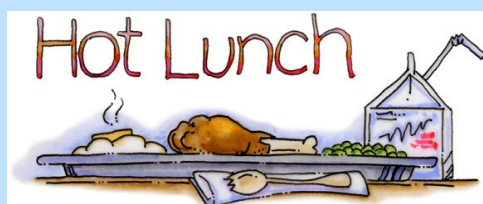
Hot Lunch Orders
