

Are carrots orange? - Home Learning Ideas

The following is a list of ideas you might like to complete at home. They give you and your child the opportunity to share learning at home and enhance the learning they are completing in their topic at school.

Ideas for home learning:

- Draw a picture of your favourite fruit or vegetable. Can you write a sentence about why you like it or what it tastes like?
- Help write the weekly shopping list - can you be in charge of this on the trip to the supermarket? Read what you have to buy and cross them off when you have found them.
- How many different fruits and vegetables do you have at home. How many of each type have you got and how many are there altogether? Can you record what you have found out on paper?
- Can you learn a song or a rhyme about food and perform it to the class?
- How many food items can you find at home or in the supermarket that begin with the following sounds? Can you write a list of the ones you have found?
- b / m / p / a / t / r / h / o
- Create a collage of your favourite fruit / vegetable.
- Follow a recipe to make a healthy meal or snack together! Use scales to measure and read the recipe together.
- Make a list of how many fruits and vegetables each member of the family eats each day for a week. Who has eaten the most? Who has eaten the least?
- What exercise could you do as a family? Could you go on a longer walk than usual - how far can you walk? Can you find a new walk somewhere around Louth and take photos of your route? Can you go on a bike ride / take a trip the park / make up exercise stations in the garden?
- What can you see growing in your garden? Can you take photos now and at the end of this term to compare and see how they have grown?
- Try some new fruit and vegetables together? Make a table of those you liked and those you didn't. Can you write what they tasted like?
- Write a story about a magical vegetable - what does it do? What happens? Bring your story in and read it to the class.
- Make / grow your own herb garden on your kitchen window sill or if you have more space grow plants or vegetables in your garden. Talk about how you will have to look after them and watch them grow!
