If you do not have access to our online ordering system and wish to place an order, please let the office know and an account will be set up or a paper form can be issued.

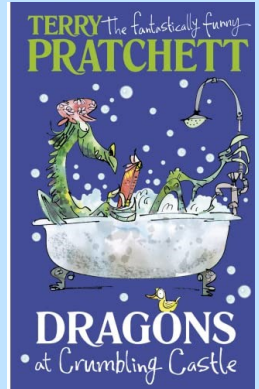
The deadline for orders is midday Thursday 20th May 2021. Please note late orders can not be accepted.

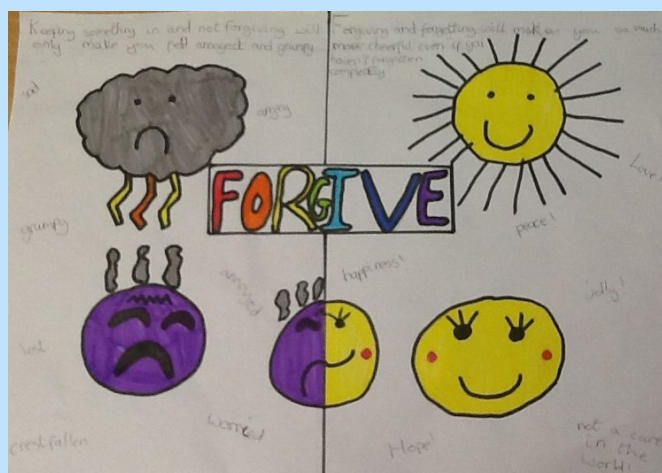
Values Champion
