Hot Lunches for September

As you will be aware our hot lunches are supplied by John Spendluffe Technology College, and in order to ensure a smooth service, they require lunch orders in 3 week blocks and need to receive these at least a week before they are due in order to manage stock and supplies etc.



With this in mind, they have asked that any hot meal orders for September are returned to them by mid July before we break up for the summer.

As Schoolmoney requires payment at the time of order for pupils in years 3 to 6, we felt it would be unfair to use the online ordering system as it would mean parents having to pay 2 months in advance. Therefore we will be sending home “paper” meal forms w/c 21st June to be returned by Friday 9th July to all pupils. Payment will not be required at this time and instead invoices will be raised via School-money and issued in September for payment.

At present, due to covid restrictions hot meals are delivered pre portioned in individual boxes and eaten in the classroom. At this time we are not able to confirm if this will still the case in September or if we will be able to return to serving lunch ourselves in the hall. As soon as updated guidance is received for schools we will of course let you know.
