Spring 2 Learn about jobs and careers	Become a palaeontologist for the day discovering dinosaur bones
Summer 1 Planting seeds Learn where our food comes from. Sitting in a tractor Raise money for a charity Go on a picnic	To plant seeds and know what it needs to grow. To develop the EYFS garden and talk to a farmer about his crops To grow and then harvest and eat new potatoes To experience and understand the importance of raising funds for charity and exercise. Plan and join in a class picnic
Summer 2 School trip Sports Day	To experience a school trip to a wildlife park to see animals from around the world. To take part in competitive sports and fun active games, working as part of a team.
